## 2 O GEOTREKKING GETTING TO KNOW THE ROCKS



## **PROGRAMME**

Rocks, stones and giant rock formations are rich in history and can reveal the earth's deepest secrets.

Geology involves several sites at Friulian Dolomites Natural Park, which offers a variety of different views and rocks.

• Meet with the nature guide in Claut piazza (PN). Rocks tell stories all over Friulian Dolomites Natural Park. At Cellina and Molassa gorges, for example, visitors can find fascinating smooth rocks unearthed by the water that have clambered to a height. Monte Dosàip also has some very particular conformations. Stories about stones become more numerous along the Periadriatic Seam in Andreis. And in Claut, fossil footprints tell the story of ancient dinosaurs. In Erto e Casso, giant one-of-a-kind books are hidden among the summit of Monte Borgà: stone slabs sit on top of one another, and visitors can learn about the earth's history by reading between the
